
Other Guidelines

Discipline Process

• Our 3 Strikes Policy—this is in regards to behavior and/or attendance. We believe that all students should respect their teachers, each other and their surroundings. If they are not being respectful, the teacher will give them a "strike." This is also in regards to their attendance. The knowledge they gain from CCD will help them grow in their faith as they embark upon their sacraments and they miss out if they are not attending class. When a child has reached 3 strikes, the student and parents must meet with Father Tim before the student will be allowed back in class.


Health

All church employees and volunteers over the age of 18 who work with children under the age of 19 are required to complete the Archdiocesan Sexual Abuse Policy Regulations.

We offer a preparation process involving the candidate, the parents/guardians, the sponsors and the parish community for those receiving sacraments. We recognize and support that the family is the foundation for the faith formation of the child. Therefore the family, especially the parents and guardians, are highly involved in this preparation process. Parents and guardians are required to attend some sessions pertaining to each of the sacraments.

The "Touching Safety" instruction class will be held on 12/4/16. You can get information by requesting a copy of the program overview and grade level subjects from the teacher or you can go to archkck.org or virtus.org if you would like to opt your child out of this class. Please return the opt-out form by 11/20/16.

Arrival Process

- Arrival time is between 9:00 am and 9:15 am except for those involved as teachers or special activity volunteers.
- Children are to enter through the church to the basement and quietly proceed to the tables with their classes. Promptly at 9:15 am the teacher will walk their students over to the school to the assigned classrooms.
- Children Preschool through 2nd grade are to be escorted into the church by an adult or older sibling.
- When children have entered the school, they may not leave the premises without parental consent and authorization from staff.

Dismissal Process

- All children are to exit the school building through the Freeman Street doors of the school.
- Children in Preschool through 2nd grade need to be picked up from their classrooms by a PARENT or OLDER SIBLING. If you plan on having someone else pick up your child, please provide a note.
- Children should be picked up at the school promptly at 10:15 am.

Attendance Expectations

Goal: All children will attend classes 100% of the time.

- Teachers and parents will work together to keep the religious education experience meaningful, positive and fun for all students.
- Teachers will keep attendance records. After 5 unexcused absences, the student and parents/guardians must meet with Father Tim before the student may return to class.

Cancellation of Classes

Cancellation of classes due to hazardous weather conditions will be called in to the local television station by the coordinator as early as possible. They will also be listed on our website at **www.shsjcc.org**. Please use your own judgement as to the road and weather conditions in your own respective areas.
